Lesson Policy, Semester Schedule, and Materials

Lesson Costs:

\$20/30-minute

\$30/45-minute

\$40/60 minute

Lessons are ongoing for the school year and happen on a weekly basis.

Lesson Policy:

Lessons must be paid for up front for the month. If you miss a lesson because you forgot, are sick, or had a conflict you will still need to pay for the lesson. If you have an emergency or I cancel the lesson, then that lesson payment will be carried forward to the next month. I do my best to schedule makeup lessons, so please inquire about these.

Semester Schedule:

I now have a studio semester schedule. This means that the year will have three semesters, with a make-up week (or break) at the end of each semester. Below is the schedule for this year.

FALL SEMESTER

September 12-December 18th

December 19-23 – Make Up Week

WINTER SEMESTER

January 2-April 22

April 23-27 – Make Up Week

SPRING SEMESTER

April 30-June 10

June 11-15 – Make Up Week

Snow Days:

My studio follows the ILS Snow Day policy. If you have any question about whether I am open or not, please call or email me. Lesson payments will be carried forward if there is a Snow Day. However, if you choose not to come for a lesson and ILS is not closed due to snow, then that lesson payment will not be carried forward as it would be treated as a missed lesson.

Books and Materials:

Students should own a metronome and a 3-ring binder for any loose sheets that I provide. I can order books for students when they are needed or if you order your own books, I can provide the ISBN numbers of the materials they will need. Metronomes can be ordered online from Amazon. I recommend a Seiko quartz metronome. It is also helpful to have an assignment notebook so that students understand what they are responsible for each week.

Summer Lessons:

I teach lessons during the Summer. Summer lessons follow the same policy as set forth above, but can be paid on a weekly basis as the Summer is usually an irregular schedule.
